Initial Incident Command

Following the completion of this course the student will:

- Understand the key principles of the Incident Command System
- Understand the roles and responsibilities of personnel within the Incident Command Structure
- Understand the management of risk at operational incidents
- Understand effective communication at operational incidents
- Be able to plan an initial response to an operational incident
- Be able to implement actions at an operational incident to meet planned objectives
- Be able to close down the operational phase of an incident.
- Be able to review a response to an operational incident.

- Course delivered in 1 x 5-day block or weekend delivery model

- Technical input
- Group based scenario training
- All students will operate as incident commander in 2 scenarios using both virtual reality and practical scenarios (live fire, extrication & HazMat)
